Exporting Instructions

IN YOU CHOOSE TO DELIVER CAR BY YOURSELF OR SELLER

- 1. You must arrive at our agents designated office between 8:30 a.m. 10:30 a.m or 12:30 p.m. 2:30 p.m. to deliver your car for export. Our US agent will provide the necessary paperwork for you to deliver the vehicle to the loading dock.
- 2. You must **leave less than** ½ **tank of gas in your car**, any surplus may be removed at your expense.
- 3. You MUST have the **ORIGINAL TITLE**. If someone other than the owner (as shown on the title) delivers the car, then the deliverer must have a notarized Power of Attorney from the owner. If there is a lien on the vehicle, then you must have the lien release from the lien-holder.
- 4. Your vehicle must be in running condition, the shipping line will not load a non running vehicle. If your vehicle will not start you will have to arrange and pay for a mechanic for the needed repairs. You may also face storage fees while your car waits for the next vessel.
- 5. You may not ship any personal items in the car except for the spare tire, tire iron and jack. All other items such as child seat, ski racks, bicycle racks and non factory installed stereos must be shipped separately. Please inform us if you have a trailer hitch, camper or cab mirrors or any other item that extends the height, width or length of your vehicle.
- 6. We recommend that you have marine insurance, it is optional. We can provide it for an additional fee, and it covers sever damage and theft with a \$1000.00USD deductible for each occurrence Insurance cost 2 % of the value of the vehicle, and a minimum coverage value of \$7000.00. If you ship without marine insurance, the shipping line has a liability limit of \$500.00 per car.
- 7. There is a terminal handling charge at the destination port. The charge varies from port to port, and is due when you pick up the car. There also may be other Customs charges, please contact the foreign port of entry for these fees.
- 8. We recommend that you bring a screwdriver to remove your American license plates when you leave your car at the pier. Take them with you and reinstall them at the port of destination.
